The heartache and despair that permeated rural Ontario was felt by landowners and farmers, throughout the province. Their struggle to survive through some of the toughest conditions since the depression, is highlighted in this documentary. The black cloud that descended on the agricultural community with the discovery of BSE in an Alberta cow and the subsequent closing of Canada's borders, sent shock waves around the country. May 20, 2003 is forever etched in the minds of those rural residents whose lives came crashing down around them. This is only part of the story.

Rural Ontario, devastated by these events, was in crisis. It was during this dark period that our government, at all three levels, decided to strike and unleashed a barrage of rules and regulations on the rural community. Despair and hopelessness turned to rage. Forced to comply and unable to, many rural businesses closed down.

The seeds of discontent had been watered and the anger that grew from this treatment, fueled a growing movement of landowners who said, "Enough is enough" and took steps to change the course of their history. This is their story.
